Umbrella

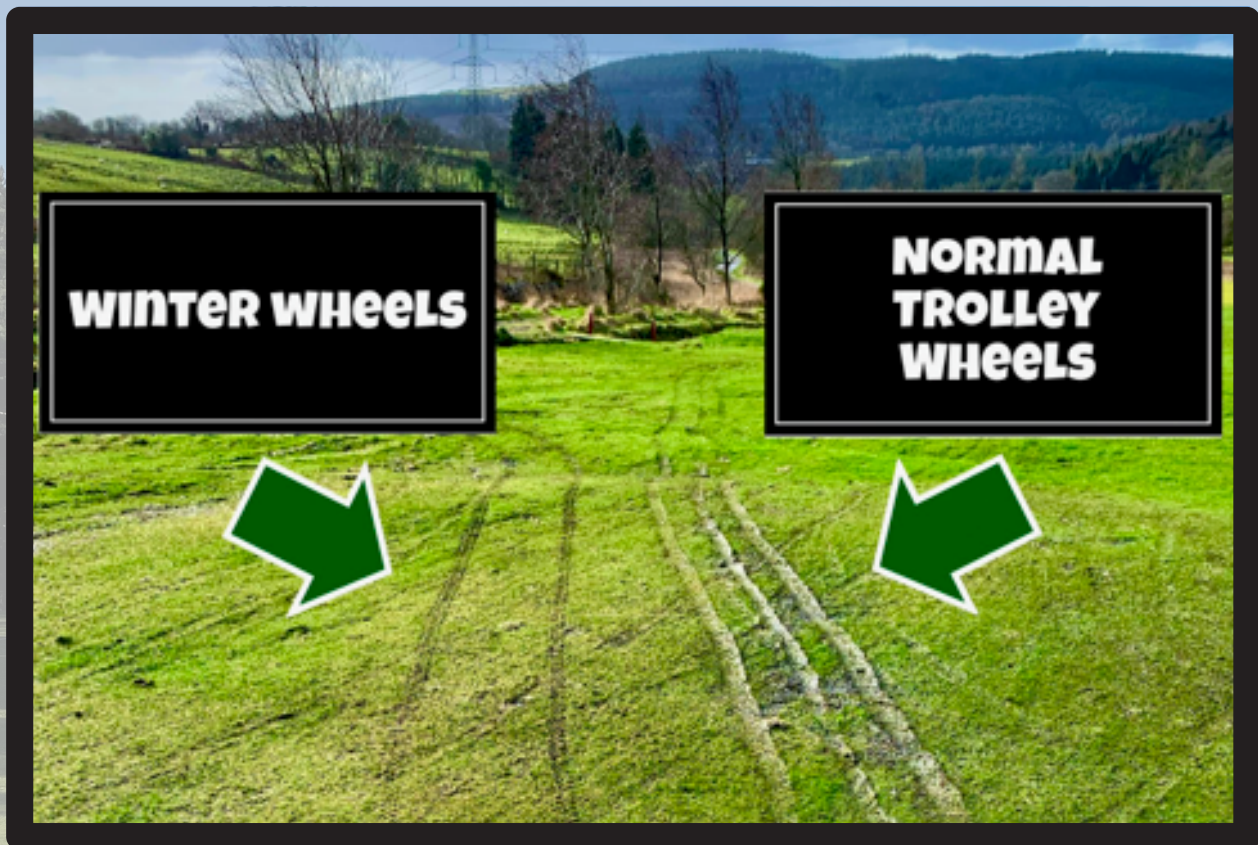

Please be a responsible golfer this winter and if you're physically able to please carry your clubs, even if trolley's are permitted.

If you must use a trolley, when allowed, please ensure you use winter wheels. With the ground being wet and soft slick wheels spin and cause damage to the course.

As you can see from the above image, winter wheels are designed to give more traction on less service area, saving the course.
